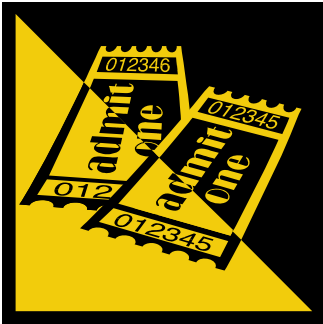

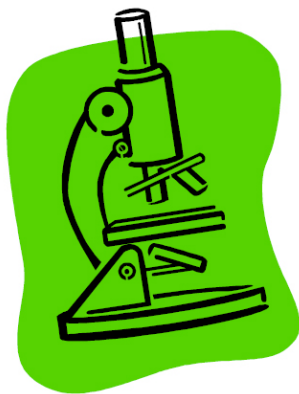

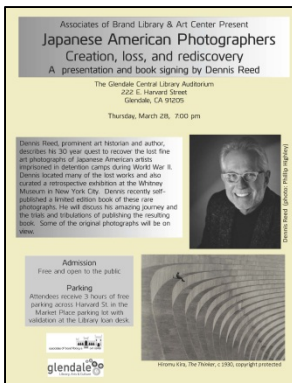
Attention Faculty, Staff and Students! Don't Miss the March 26th STARS Workshop on "Study Smarter, Not Harder"

Free Music Performances at Valley College—LAVC Music Department to Hold Its Free Wednesday Concerts on March 27 & April 10

LAVC Music Department to present two free concerts as part of its Free Wednesday Concert Series. There will be a free piano performance by Aaron McClaskey on Wednesday, March 27 at 1 p.m. in the Music Recital Hall (Music 106), and a performance by Christian Nova, baritone, and Frank Garvey, piano, on Wednesday, April 10 at 1 p.m. in the Music Recital Hall (Music 106). Aaron McClaskey is both a classical and a jazz musician, and his concert will feature a performance of works by Chopin, Scriabin, Ravel, Gershwin, and Bill Evans.
