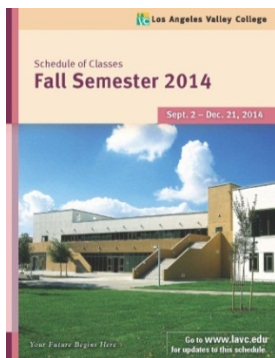

Did You Know? LAVC's New Parking Structure is Now Open

Los Angeles Valley College's brand-new Parking Structure opened on Tuesday, September 2. Staff and accessible parking will be available on the first level, and students/guest parking will be available on the second, third and fourth floors. Please note: Half of the parking on the second level will be closed until further notice. Access to the Parking Structure for students and guest will be from Ethel Avenue; faculty and staff will need to access the Parking Structure from Emelita Street (street on the north side of the Parking Structure). The Parking Structure will be open Monday-Friday from 5:30 a.m.-12 midnight. The new Parking Structure can accommodate approximately 1,200 vehicles, and features a counter at the entrance that notes the available parking spaces on each floor. Don't Forget! LAVC's Fulton Avenue Entrance will be Temporarily Closed for the First Two Weeks of the Fall Semester

From September 2-12, the College Sheriff will temporarily close the driveway to the main Fulton Avenue college entrance (at Hatteras Street), and will block off all left turns into the campus from southbound lanes of Fulton Avenue and from the eastbound lanes of Burbank Boulevard to help ease traffic congestion at the beginning of the semester. In addition, it will have officers and cadets stationed at the entrance of all student parking lots (Lots A, B, C, D, F, G, L and M) from Monday-Thursday between 7 a.m.-1 p.m. and 4-10 p.m. to help direct traffic and close full parking lots. During the first two weeks of the semester:

- Access will still be available to Access Services Paratransit Vehicles to the disabled student drop-off and pick-up location.
- Access to staff parking in College Road North and College Road South, and the disabled student drop-off and pick-up location in the main entrance circle will only be accessible from the Burbank Avenue entrance to Lot A entrance and the Fulton Avenue entrance to Lot B.
- If the parking lot is closed, faculty/staff must show their valid Valley College parking permit to the officer or cadet stationed at the parking lot entrance.
- All staff lots will be made available to students after 7 p.m. in an effort to provide as much parking as possible.

All students will be given a two-week grace period for parking (in student lots only); however, parking permits will be required at all times in faculty/staff parking areas. Students are encouraged to purchase their parking permit from the [LAVC Business Office](#). All legal violations will be enforced. The college Sheriff reminds everyone to obey traffic laws and drive safely. Visit the [LAVC Campus Map](#) to view entrances to parking areas.

LAVC Fall 2014 Open Classes List is Available Online.** The LAVC Office of Academic Affairs posts a Fall 2014 Open Classes List online for students registering for classes for the Fall 2014 semester. Incorrect Non-Resident Tuition noted in the Fall 2014 Schedule.** The Fall 2014 Schedule of Classes incorrectly noted the non-resident tuition of \$193 per unit; the non-resident tuition is supposed to be \$215 per unit. The LACCD Board of Trustees adopted an increase in non-resident fees to include a \$22 per semester unit capital outlay fee; view the LACCD Board of Trustee action.
