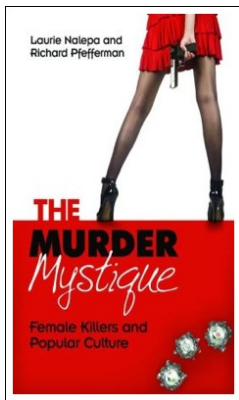

**LACCD Appoints an Interim Chancellor, and Selects New Presidents at LA Trade Tech and LA City College**

***On Wednesday, May 1, the Los Angeles Community College District Board of Trustees approved the appointment of Dr. Adriana D. Barrera as Interim Chancellor, and the selection of Los Angeles Deputy Mayor Laurence B. Frank to be the new president of Los Angeles Trade-Technical College and Renee Martinez to be the new president of Los Angeles City College.*** Barrera, who is currently the District's Deputy Chancellor, will serve as Interim Chancellor effective July 1, 2013, through the start of employment of the regular chancellor. Frank will assume his duties in July, taking over for Dr. Roland "Chip" Chapdelaine, who is retiring after seven years as president of the downtown Los Angeles community college. Martinez replaced Dr. Jamillah Moore who left to become chancellor of the Ventura County Community College District.

***Los Angeles Valley College has released a newly updated construction sequencing diagram for the college's \$626 million bond renovation and building project.*** The revised diagram includes an updated projected timeline for when Prop A/AA/J construction projects are anticipated to take place on campus between April 2013-March 2016. ### Cast of LAVC Theater Art's Production of Avenue Q Raised Money for the Children's Burn Foundation and Meets Show's Co-Writer/Lyricist

***The LAVC Theater Arts Department had a successful two-week run of its production of the Tony-award winning musical Avenue Q; the show raised \$1,027.57 for the Children's Burn Foundation and the cast met the musical's co-writer/lyricist Jeff Marx.*** Prior to each of the show's four performances, audience members were asked to give their spare change during the show's "The Money Song", and the money raised would benefit the Children's Burn Foundation. The cast decided to donate the money to the organization since one of the college's theater arts students, Marena Rosado, and the daughter of LAVC faculty member Cathy Pyles, Alexi, are both burn survivors. The Burn Foundation assists children from age 0-18 in burn recovery and teaches fire prevention; it also loaned the cast its "teaching tolerance" puppets for the show's auditions and rehearsal period. In addition, Jeff Marx, one of the co-writer/lyricist for "Avenue Q", attended the show's closing night performance, and he brought his Tony Award to show the cast. ### College trustees appoint two presidents, acting chancellor

Two college presidents and an acting chancellor were named by the Los Angeles Community College District Board of Trustees. Laurence B. Frank, who is deputy chief of staff for Los Angeles Mayor Antonio Villaraigosa, will become the new president of Los Angeles Trade-Technical College effective July 1. He will succeed current President Roland "Chip" Chapdelaine, who is retiring after seven years at the downtown Los Angeles campus. The trustees also named Renee D. Martinez as president of Los Angeles City College. Martinez had been serving as the interim president since last August, after former President Jamillah Moore left to become chancellor of the Ventura County Community College District. Chancellor Daniel LaVista announced earlier this year that he would resign his post leading the nine-campus district at the end of June. Trustees appointed Adriana D. Barrera, currently deputy chancellor, to serve as acting chancellor until LaVista's successor is named.
