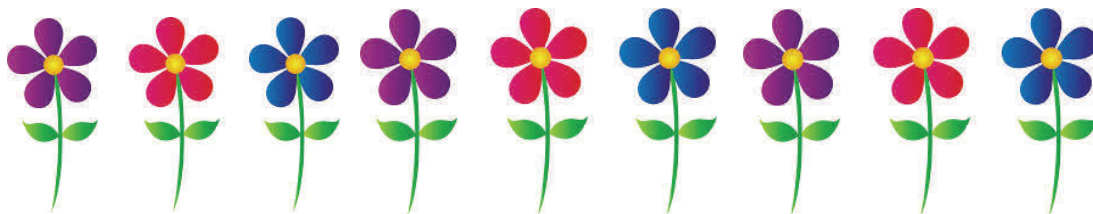

Welcome to Spring 2017

Dear Faculty,

Spring 2017 will be a busy time for the campus and Student Services. I want to briefly share with you some updates.

New SIS Portal—Phase One of the new SIS has launched. Students applying for Admission for Fall 2017 are using the new system. All new and continuing students will have access to the portal starting February 21. Registration for Summer will take place using DEC, but registration for Fall 2017 will use the new system and start on May 15. All communication in the portal will be @mycollege.edu. SIS portal training for faculty is schedule to take place sometime this Spring. We will let you know.

FYE : First Year Experience—Student Equity funds have allowed us to hire a First Year Experience coordinator: Cynthia Lopez. Cynthia will be connecting services for LAVC’s student onboarding programs including the PASO Grant, Summer Bridge, LA Promise, and the Student Equity Cultural Cohorts. The FYE Coordinator’s efforts will minimize duplication of efforts, maximize funding, and assess best practices.

Mosaic Center—The LAVC Mosaic Center will open on February 6. The Center is located on the second floor of the Student Services Center building. The old ASU office was converted into a workable space for Veterans, Black Scholars, and Mi Comunidad students. It will serve as a space to gather, connect, and study. Llanet Martin, the Student Equity Director, will oversee the space dedicated as a safe zone for students.

A Day in the Life—A Day in the Life is a campus-wide experiential professional development project designed to create a shared vision of student success . The project, intended to increase awareness of the experience of students participating in the matriculation process, will start at the end of February. The focus is on the critical role that each employee (staff, faculty, administrators) plays in the success of students at LAVC. More information will be forthcoming. I hope you will consider being a part of the team.
