Requirements

- 3.0 GPA or higher
- Maintain Full-Time status (12 Units)
- Have 1 year remaining prior to transferring
- U.S. Citizen, National, or permanent resident
- Committed to attending a Doctoral Program after completion of bachelor's degree

- A monthly stipend of \$720 up to 3 years
- Travel Funds to present at professional conferences
- Research Funds towards research materials
- Professional Development
- Scholarship for a GRE preparatory course
