CLASS POLICIES

TEST

All tests are multiple choice. You will need SCAN - TRON answer sheets (Form 882-E—the green one), a No. 2 pencil, and a clean eraser. Your lowest test score will be dropped in computing your final grade in the course. If you miss a test without notifying me before, you will receive a zero for that test.. Sample tests with answers may be downloaded and printed from the website.
There are no make –ups for missed tests.

GRADING

HOMEWORK

Homework (with your name and roll # in plain sight) is due on test days. Complete and correct homework earns you one point. No late homework is accepted.

CALCULATORS

Basic arithmetic skills are a prerequisite for this class. You may use a calculator at any time, but **sharing or borrowing of calculators is not permitted during tests. No programmable calculators or computers. Put away cell phones during tests.**

ATTENDANCE

Attendance in class is required. More than 4 unexcused absences or if you miss the 1st or 2nd meeting, you're out of the class. It is **your** responsibility to drop before the deadline (check class schedule) to avoid an "F". Class will begin on time and if you arrive after class begins you will be marked tardy. 3 tardies equal 1 absence. If you leave early without permission, you will be marked absent.

CLASS PARTICIPATION

Every student is required to go to the board 3 times during the semester to work a problem. Only volunteers will be chosen, nobody will be put on the spot, but the **penalty for non-compliance is that your final grade will be lowered one whole letter grade for not going 3 times.**

EXTRA CREDIT

After you have completed your required three trips to the board, you can earn one bonus point for every trip afterward.

CELL PHONES

If an electronic device produces sound during class, you will be asked to leave for that day.

No tolerance! Any conduct resembling cheating is grounds for a "0" on that test and a report to authorities for disciplinary action.
