International Student Tuition and Fees

As non-residents of California, International students are required to pay a non-refundable \$ 50 application fee, non-resident tuition and SEVIS fees. International students are not eligible for financial aid. Fees are subject to change.

Non-Resident Tuition: International student non-resident tuition is \$299 per unit (\$299 x 12 units). You are required to enroll in a minimum of 12 units each fall and spring semester.	\$3,558.00	\$7,176.00
<b>Enrollment Fee:</b> All students must pay an enrollment fee of \$46 per unit (\$46 x 12 units). International students are required to pay this fee in addition to the non-resident tuition. It is anticipated that the enrollment fee may increase as a result of legislative action. The increase would apply to all California Community Colleges.	\$552.00	\$1,104.00
Student Health Fee: All students at Los Angeles Valley College are required to pay an \$19 Student Health Fee per semester. The Student Health Fee allows you access to the Student Health Center where you can receive limited low-cost medical services. Medical Insurance: International students <u>MUST</u> purchase Los Angeles Valley College Medical Insurance Plan.	\$677.58	\$1,355.16
<b>Student Representation Fee:</b> Student Representation Fee is charged every semester. This fee supports student representatives involved in governmental affairs.	\$2.00	\$4.00
<b>Associated Student Union (ASU):</b> ASU is student government at LAVC. It is designed to give students a voice in how the college is governed.	\$10.00	\$20.00
<b>Parking:</b> A parking permit is required for cars at all times when using campus parking facilities during regular school hours. <b>Optional – not included in the total cost.</b>	\$20.00	\$40.00
Books and Supplies: Textbooks and supplies cost approximately \$1,581.84 per year.	\$790.92	\$1,581.84
<b>SEVIS Fee:</b> The United States Federal Government requires that international students be registered in SEVIS every semester; therefore, the college has a \$25 SEVIS Maintenance Fee each semester.	\$25.00	\$50.00
