After completing the assessment students will have a Meyers Briggs Type Inventory code which describes their personality type. Occupational Outlook Handbook (OOH) -- This site provides the complete content of the OOH which is published by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. The OOH has information on over 200 occupations. It describes the training, typical work activities, and salary range for jobs. www.bls.gov

O*NET -- This is the occupational network database which provides detailed information on more than 200 occupations. It is an excellent source for learning about the nuts and bolts of occupations. The occupational descriptions describe skills needed to do the job, values that are important, and activities pertaining to the field. Job outlook and salary information also are listed.
