



How to join The Math Lab Workshops?

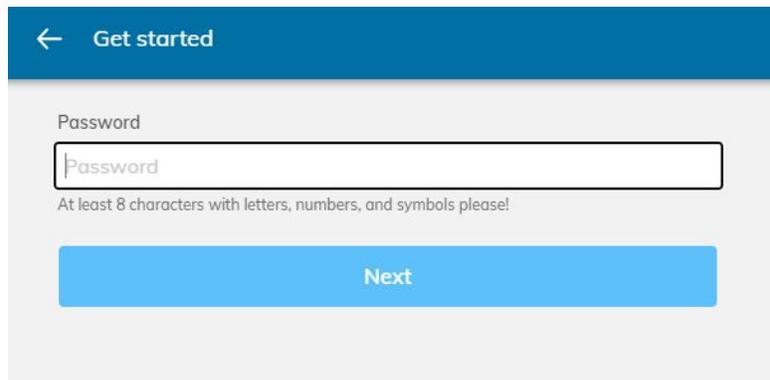
Q: How do I access online tutoring?

1. ARC's tutoring service will be held online. To access tutoring, please go to <https://web.penjiapp.com>
2. On the Penji Social Learning webpage, click "Get Started" if this is your first-time signing in and you will be prompted to create an account. If you have already created an account, press "Already used Penji before? Sign back in."



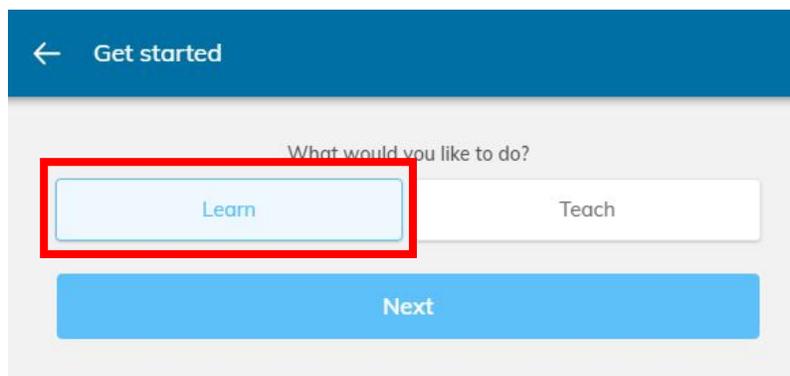
3. After clicking "Get Started", you will be asked to fill in some information. Please fill in your student e-mail and agree to the terms of services and privacy policy.

4. After creating filling in your student e-mail, you will be asked to create a password.



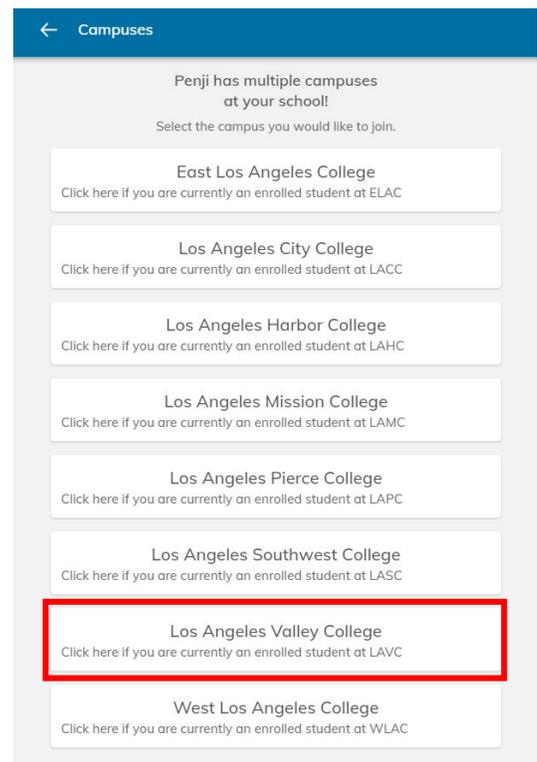

5. After creating a password and hitting next, you will be asked to choose between "learn" and "teach", please press "learn" and then click "next".





6. You will now be asked to choose what LACCD college you are enrolled in. Please click on "Los Angeles Valley College".

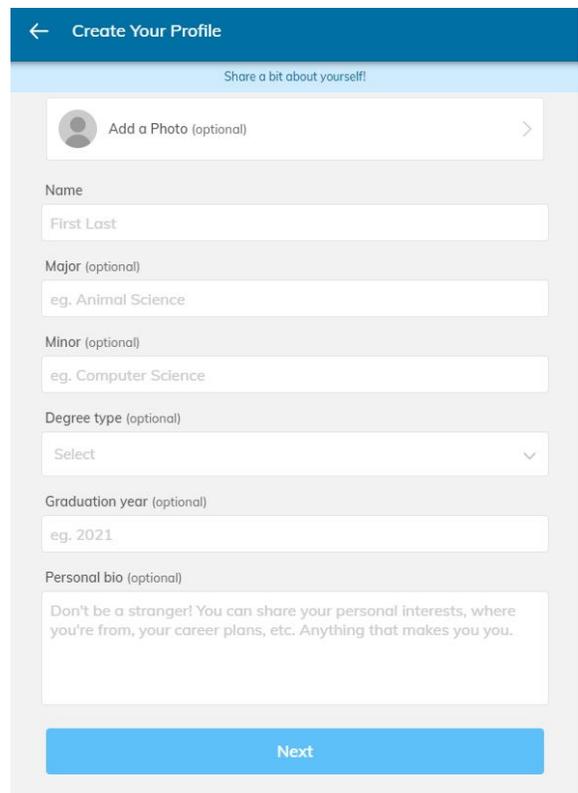

9. An e-mail verification will be sent to your student e-mail to verify your account. Once you verify your e-mail and account, you can begin accessing ARC's tutoring services.





Q: How do I access the LAVC Math Lab Workshops?


1. After choosing the LAVC | The Math Lab in the Penji homepage, you will enter into the LAVC | Math lab where you will see three buttons: 1) Math Lab Homepage, 3) Join Workshops/Group Sessions, 4) View drop-in tutoring .




2. The LAVC Math Lab will be using Zoom for workshops. Click on “Learn” and for the workshops click on “Join Workshops/group Tutoring”.




3. You will then be prompted to pick a class. Please click “Join a class”.




4. Click on Math 259/260 Workshops.




5. Click on Math 259/260 Workshops to make sure it is highlighted in blue and click next.




6. On the following page, click Math 259/260 Weekly Workshops to make sure it is highlighted in blue and click join.
