Sebastian Diaz: The Bond Working Committee discussed the Construction Projects on Campus. They plan to update doors in three phases. Future storm water projects – filter out the rain water. LACCD has to retain the first inch of rain for every rain fall so they’re trying to convert areas of LAVC for storm water retention. AHS Building has leakage and plan to do an exploratory demolition. The outdoor amphitheater is beginning to form. The pipe running throughout campus will aid the water and power. They also plan on constructing a Tap Studio on Campus.
Samuel Arias: The Smash Brother’s Fundraiser event held on May 2, 2019 was a success. The event received **\$375** and participated clubs will receive a deposit of **\$75** by May 21, 2019. Samuel made a budget request for purchasing two-dimensional lawn games such as Ping Bond Table, Jenga, and a Connect Four. These events will be used for future club days. He also purchased **ASU** letters for the ASU Banquet and future ASU Sponsor events. He asked ICC Representatives for assistance for molding together the letters.
Adian Boyles: Attended the Facility Planning Committee and they discussed three items. 1) Program Review – problems and solutions on Facility Planning Committee and other Committees. 2) Guest Speakers from a company collaborating with LAVC on their master plan. The master plan is a funded project to create a more visually appealing campus. Draft will be presented in September 2019. 3) Dream Catchers asked the committee for a recommendation for demolishing an existing building in their favor of creating a Dream center. The facility abstained due to a lack of information. Aidan made a budget allocation for another Smash Brother’s Fundraiser event, but for **\$800**.
