- A. Grad Guru: Raquel Sanchez, Student Engagement Coordinator, set up a Grad Guru group to inform ICC representatives of upcoming events, ICC meetings, and deadlines. Requested to download the app to be put in the group.
- B. Banquet: Sebastian made an announcement about the annual ASU Banquet in May. Requested that all interested clubs notify either in-person or through email.
- C. Earth Day: Urban Forestry Committee requested collaboration with ASU to do a joint Earth Day event on April 24 during Club Day. Grace then provided recommendations as to what sort of ways to participate while maintaining the theme of being environmentally-conscious. - D. Club Recertification/Chartering: Sebastian reminded the board that recertification paperwork must be completed and turned in by the deadline on March 21. Representative from the Scripting Monarchs club stated why they should be chartered in the Spring semester. They were inactive for about a year, but are looking to recharter to request funding for equipment and are open to anyone interested.
Writers motions to charter the Scripting Monarchs Club. Elohist seconded the motion. Unanimous vote of approval. Motion passed.
- E. ICC Representative Appointment: Samuel Arias and Aiden Boyles applied to be appointed to become ICC Representatives on the Executive Council. They each had the opportunity to present why they would like to be appointed for the position, answering a series of questions.
Writers motions to appoint Samuel Arias as ICC Representative. LGBTQ+ seconded the motion. Unanimous vote of approval. Motion passed.
Business motions to appoint Aiden Boyles as ICC Representative. Writers seconded the motion. Business, Elohist, International, Engineers, Writers, Scripting, Cinema, and Sociology voted in favor of the motion. Psychology, Broadcast, LGBTQ+, BSU, and RCA voted in opposition of the motion. Dream Catchers, Hillel 818, Math, Puente, VCP, and Veterans abstain from voting. Majority vote of approval. Motion passed.
