- VII. **Open Forum:**

Voting polls are open from 10 A.M. to 4 P.M. but students can also vote on their student portal. Aidan, spoke on behalf of Samuel Arias, distributed a Smash Ultimate Fundraiser sign up sheet to ICC Representatives. The deadline to register is on May 1, 2019 at student life office. XI. **New Business:**

- B. **Club Tablecloths:** Sebastian spoke on behalf of Elijah, commissioner of Publicity, who was approved in purchasing twenty-nine (29) tablecloths for chartered clubs. The tablecloths will display club, ASU and LAVC logo. Funds will be taken from the ASU savings account. If clubs do not have a logo they will meet with Elijah and his team of graphic designers to create one. If clubs do have a logo, they must email Sebastian the appropriate image as soon as possible.
- C. **EC Report:** Sebastian informed the club of the recent sixteen (16) approved items:
- i. Lion's den Karaoke (\$40) Funds will go towards food
 - ii. Lion's Den Movie Hour (\$90) Funds will go towards popcorn (\$20) and a Netflix Card (\$70).
 - iii. Lion's Den Board Game (\$270) Funds for board games (\$250) and snacks (\$20). Allocated from savings.
 - iv. Smash Ultimate Competition (\$317) Funds for Nintendo pins, pizza, water snacks, and \$50 grand prize.
 - v. Club Supplies/Operations (\$417.09) Scripting Monarchs funds were approved for supplies with a two (2) year lifespan and a sodding iron. Open to students.
 - vi. ASU Letter (\$510) Four foot tall letters for ASU sponsor events.
 - vii. Mental Health Workshop (\$350) Scheduled event – May 13, 2019 – funds were approved for catering. Allocated from savings.
 - viii. Open Mic Night (\$450) Abilities Club's budget request was approved for their Open Mic Night event for chicken wings.
 - ix. Lawn Games for Banquet (\$500) Funds were approved in purchasing two dimensional games – Jenga, Chess set, Connect Four, and Ping Pong – for ASU sponsored events. Allocated from savings.
 - x. SharkTank Viewing Party (\$255.92) Business Club's request was approved for food and raffle.
 - xi. Club Day Treats (\$85) Anime & Manga Club's budget request was approved on purchasing treats for club day – May 8, 2019.
 - xii. LAVC Pride Mixer (\$250) GSA's budget request was approved on purchasing food and supplies for the event – May 17, 2019.
 - xiii. Sexual Assault Workshop (\$250) Funds were approved on purchasing food and other expenses. ASU sponsored workshop.
 - xiv. Armenian Remembrance Plaque Ceremony (\$500) Funds were approved on purchasing a concrete bench.
 - xv. Club Tablecloths (\$3,600) Funds were approved on purchasing twenty-nine (29) tablecloths for chartered clubs. Allocated from savings.
 - xvi. Trash Clean-Up/Recycling Clean-Up (\$350) Eco Advocates' budget request was approved on purchasing food for event(s). Trash Clean-Up on April 30, 2019 and Recycling Clean-Up is on May 2, 2019.

xvii. Increase Printing Pages: Chartered clubs can now print up to sixty (60) pages per event.

- D. **Website Club List:** Aidan is currently updating the club's information on the LAVC Website. Since the last ICC meeting he has received over 60% responses from clubs. He only needs an email confirmation and/or updated response from the following clubs: Dream Catchers, Fosters', Hillel 818, Physics, Sociology, V.C.P., and Veterans.
- E. **Selection of Faculty Marshal for Graduation:** Grace spoke on behalf of Nr. Negrete. She requested from the ICC Representatives to select a faculty member for LAVC graduation walk. ICC Representatives were only allowed to cast their vote once. The ICC elected Dr. Wallis – thirteen (13) votes – to be the faculty marshal.
