LA VALLEY COLLEGE TO OFFER ONLY COURSES FOR SPECIAL PROGRAMS THIS SUMMER

Students are encouraged to look for available classes at other area colleges

VALLEY GLEN, CA – Los Angeles Valley College (LAVC) announced today that the only summer session classes to be offered this year will be those that are part of special or year-round programs. The Cooperative Education Program will also offer a few classes this summer, which are open to the public, but students will need to obtain an add card from the instructor in order to enroll.

"Valley College is not able to provide a traditional range of courses this summer," said Dr. A. Susan Carleo, president of Los Angeles Valley College. "Instead, the college will be focusing on offering most of its courses during the Fall and Spring semesters."

Classes during the summer will have extremely limited enrollment. A list of classes offered will be posted on the LAVC Web site in the coming weeks. Students who are eligible to take these classes will be given an add card directly from the instructor. Add cards must then be turned into Admissions & Records for processing.

"Unfortunately, we aren't offering a whole lot," said Sandy Mayo, VP of Academic Affairs. "We are encouraging students who are looking for summer classes to look at other area colleges."
