III. After You Apply – Admissions Decisions

If you applied for regular Fall 2024 admission to any university, each campus you applied to should have sent an email to create an applicant portal. Admission decisions will be posted here, along with information about submitting transcripts, AP scores, and additional forms. Check each campus portal frequently. Contact the Office of Undergraduate/Transfer Admissions at your desired campus if you have not received an invitation to create one. Please visit the <u>University of California Admissions decisions page</u> to review their policies regarding provisional admission, review of admission decisions, and waitlists.

Each campus that accepts you for admission will issue a Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) form. It is

recommended to wait until all decisions have been sent before submitting your SIR to your campus.

- California State University Deadline: May 1 or later (please check each campus you applied)
- University of California Deadline: June 1 (UC does not currently anticipate extending this)

IV. Accepting a UC Offer of Admission

Students can accept an admission offer by agreeing to the provisions/conditions outlined in the offer and submitting their Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) with the SIR deposit to reserve their space at a campus. The SIR deposit is \$250. Some important things to keep in mind about accepting a UC admission offer:

- 1. Students can accept only one admission offer from one UC campus.
- 2. The SIR deposit is applied to the student's first enrollment term tuition.
- 3. Students that qualified for the UC application fee waiver may also qualify to defer their SIR deposit until financial aid is disbursed.
- 4. The SIR deposit is nonrefundable and non-transferable.
- 5. Further documentation regarding residency status for tuition determination purposes may be required. Learn more about residency for tuition purposes.

VI. UCLA's 25th Annual STOMP Conference – Friday, April 19

VII. UCLA Care Extender Program – Summer and Fall 2024

UCLA Health's <u>Care Extender Program</u> provides opportunities for volunteers to gain clinical experience and interact with patients at a UCLA Health facility. Through patient contact and volunteer involvement, Care Extenders gain first-hand experience on the role of healthcare providers by volunteering in various departments at UCLA's Westwood or Santa Monica facility. Care Extenders are trained to assist Medical Center staff to gain an insider's understanding of hospital operations.

The Spring 2024 application closed on April 4, but <u>attending the next Orientation</u> allows students to complete an application to be considered for Summer or Fall 2024.

VIII. UCLA's AAP Transfer Summer Program – July 31-September 14, 2024

The AAP Freshmen Transfer Summer Program (FTSP) is a rigorous *seven-week residential academic summer program* that prepares first generation, low-income, historically underrepresented students, to successfully transition to UCLA by exposing students to the rigor and demands of academic life, and to campus programs, services, learning resources, and networks.
